Our Klickitat Community In the Canyon


Considered one of the state's best kept secrets, Klickitat County offers a variety of historical, cultural, and recreational activities. World class windsurfing sites are easily accessible along the scenic Columbia River. The Maryhill Museum of Art and Stonehenge are two popular nearby tourist attractions. Goldendale, the county seat, is about 30 minutes northeast of Klickitat. Anyone interested in astronomy will enjoy the highly acclaimed observatory operated by the Washington State Department of Parks. Horsethief Lake State Park, offering a petroglyph tour and rock climbing, is 40 minutes east of the Klickitat/Lyle junction. Klickitat is only 90 minutes from Portland, Oregon. Along the way drivers enjoy incredible views of the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic area. Snow skiing at Mt. Hood, hiking at Beacon Rock and Multnomah Falls, and camping at the many state parks are all available within a short driving distance.

JOB SUMMARY

Implement varied teaching methods that support diverse student learning styles. Deliver interesting, challenging, and developmentally appropriate learning activities. Implement curriculum and classroom based assessments that align with state learning standards. Implement research based strategies that support teaching at-risk children. Maintain records and communicate with parents and the community at large as needed.

Students participate in comprehensive academic, activity, and athletic programs in a grades K-5 elementary school, a 6-8 middle school, and a grades 9-12 secondary school. Graduates are currently attending major universities and technical programs across the nation. Students continue to meet and exceed state achievement proficiency requirements and many have been recognized for outstanding accomplishments. Parents and the community strongly support our students and their successes.



A superior professional staff of about 30 full and part-time employees and several Education Service District 112 based employees prepare graduates for virtually any post-high school option. High achievement and well-rounded development of our students are important priorities for the staff, parents, and the Klickitat Community.

Our School

Klickitat is a K-12 school district serving about 80 students on a single campus site. The community is proud of the well maintained school facilities consisting of an elementary building, gymnasium/ multi-purpose building, and a secondary building. The District office is located in the secondary building. The school district also owns the newly renovated community center and park on the north end of town and the bus garage and play fields on the south end of town. The district administrative staff consists of a full-time superintendent/K-12 principal. The district employs a staff of about 30 and works collaboratively with the community as well as with local and regional agencies.

Klickitat School District has a successful history, having been designated both as a Distinguished School and a National Blue Ribbon School. The district enjoys a stable staff working together to provide the best possible learning and developmental opportunities for students. Klickitat School District provides a school-wide Title I program and a Learning Assistance Program as well as a Highly Capable Program. Special Education services are provided by ESD 112 school based and itinerant staff.

The district has been the recipient of a number of significant grants such as GEAR-UP and STEM among others. School staff works hard to use size as an advantage and stand ready to engage in professional dialog directed toward continuous improvement. The district also houses the local Head Start Program and provides a regional High Ropes course.
